

WALKS AND EXPLORATIONS

GREENWAY

6 km on the northern shore

From La Maison du Lac:

- **East Bank: 3 km of passable path** to discover the wildest part of the lake, with beautiful views. Access to the water is prohibited.
- **West Bank: 3 km of paved road** to access the beaches and snack bars.

LA COMBE

In the bend, a remarkable protected natural area is visible from the roadside, with a very pronounced emerald green color, reminiscent of a lagoon!

SOUGEY LEISURE BASE

From the park or the beach, magnificent view over the lake, its islands and the Épine mountain.

- **Nature walk (3 km round trip, about 40 minutes walking):** from the far end of the car park to the church of Saint-Alban-de-Montbel, which majestically overlooks the lake.
- Access to the church by car is possible, following the road to Saint-Alban-de-Montbel.

THE MARSH OF THE TRAIN

STATION AND THE THIERS CANAL

A classified biotope area with various lacustrine wetland habitats: meadows, heathlands, and woodlands

- **Marked trail (1.5 km round trip):** from the car park at Lépin-le-Lac beach, take the path towards the port on the left side of the beach, then follow the trail to the left to reach the Thiers Canal. Upon exiting the forest, return on the left side along the railway track.

AIGUEBELETTE PORT

A short walk along the port with a lovely view of the lake islands. Remarkable boathouse on the beach. On site, picnic area and bars/restaurants.

AQUATIC EXPLORATION

With the boat of your choice:

- Explore the lake independently: plan for **1 hour (north of the lake) to 2 hours 30 min. (full tour)**.
- Follow the **orientation course on the lake (1 hour 30 min. to 2 hours, all levels)**. Discover the natural heritage of the lake in an original and playful way. Support map available at the Tourist Office.

OUR DOG FRIENDS

Your faithful companion can accompany you, on a leash, on greenways and trails.

To cool them off in summer, consider making a stop:

- at the ports: Nances to the north or Aiguebelette-le-Lac to the south of the lake,
- along the Leysse river.

You can also rent a boat from Vertes Sensations.

Navigation fee

CCLA

If you are sailing on the lake with your own equipment, you will have to pay the navigation fee. This fee covers the operating costs of the surveillance and preservation of the natural environment carried out by the Communauté de communes du lac d'Aiguebelette. Buy it on cccla.fr or at the reception of the CCLA, during opening hours.



In accordance with the law, you must bring a life jacket for each person on your boat, and wear it at all times on kayaks and paddleboards.


